What is “Deflowered in Seconds”?

A detailed manual created by Castlegar area men Jason Osachoff and Curtis Delikatny, posted on Facebook February 19, 2011. The manual explicitly advocates and counsels other men on how to target, sexually exploit and abuse teenage girls as young as 13 years old.

How have the Castlegar RCMP responded?

The RCMP have warned Osachoff and Delikatny. The page has been removed from Facebook but no charges have been laid.

Why should criminal charges be laid?

“*Deflowered in Seconds*” meets the *Criminal Code* definition of child pornography under 163.1.1 (b) which defines child pornography as:

any written material or visual representation that advocates or counsels sexual activity with a person under the age of eighteen years that would be an offence under this Act.

In “*Deflowered in Seconds*” Osachoff and Delikatny counsel other men on how to lure, manipulate, sexually assault and exploit girls as young as 13 years of age. The authors advocate and counsel other men on how to use alcohol, blackmail through threatening to distribute naked pictures/video of girls and threats of social assassination to coerce girls into sexual activity.

Quotes from the manual that incite criminal acts against girls:

- Sexual Assault:

“Booze: Alcohol is the key for a rookie and sometimes a pro; it more depends on the personality of the specimen. Remember: They aren't sluts, they were drunk.”

- Production and Distribution of Child pornography:

“Get some sort of blackmail on the girls so if they find out about each other they couldn't fuck your system up even if they wanted to. Naked pictures/video footage of them doing things is a good and easy start. The more dirt and leverage; the better”.

Additional quotes from “*Deflowered in Seconds*”:

Osachoff and Delikatny use dehumanizing and objectifying language to refer to teenage girls, such as “prey”, “specimens” “LGs” (little girls), “sluts”, “cunts” and “cling-ons”:

“There are three basic classes of specimens. The sluts, the cunts and the clingons. There are other advanced exceptions because certain specimens adapt quicker than others to our techniques than other specimens would, but thankfully we make editions not final copies for the readers to keep updated with new ideas and strategies. It's okay, we are professionals.”

“Remember guys, bros before hoes. LG's aren't real people, just girls who have mother/father issues. Manipulate it and own the night, this process is so easy. We have objectophilia, Pun intended.”

“This stops the porn use and begins the specimen abuse.”
